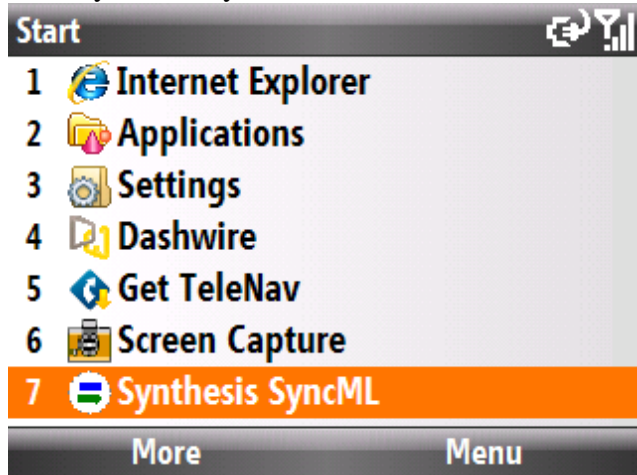


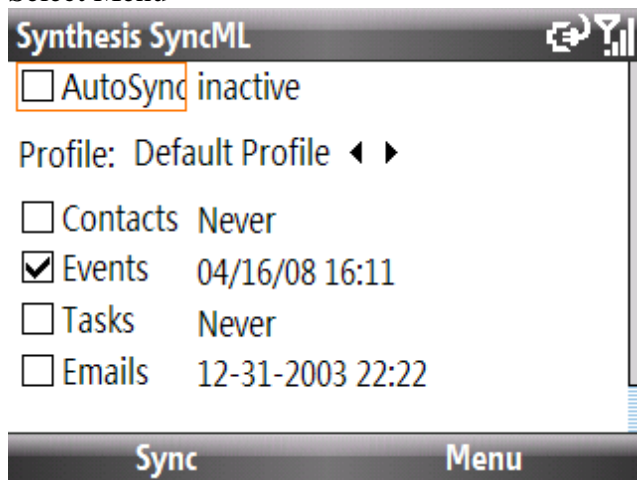
Configuring Synthesis SyncML to Connect to the Oracle Calendar Server

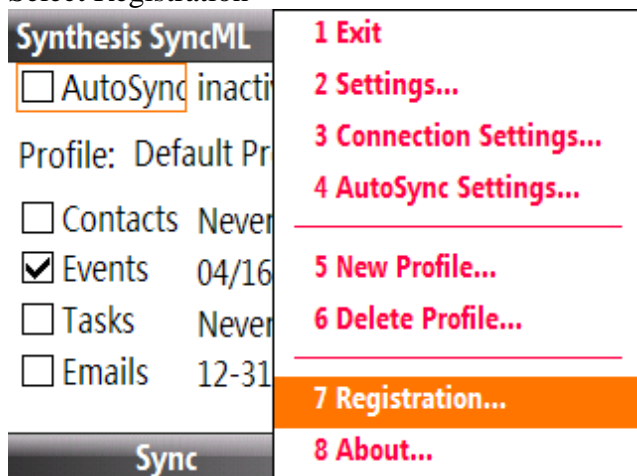
1. Start Synthesis SyncML



2. Select Menu



3. Select Registration



4. Under "Name and e-mail" enter the registration name and email address.

5. Under "Registration" enter the license key.
6. Click Save

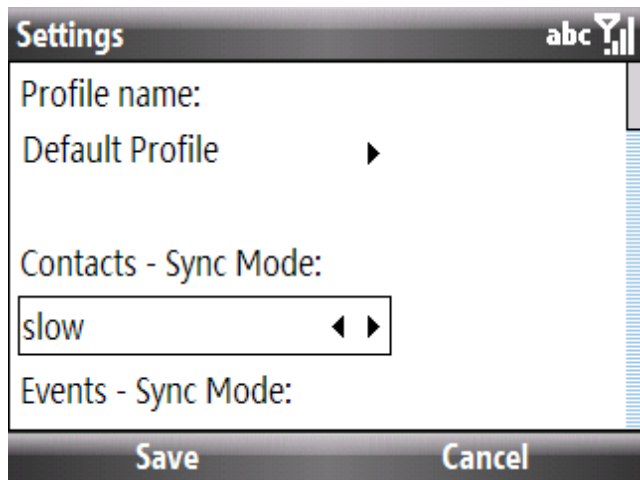

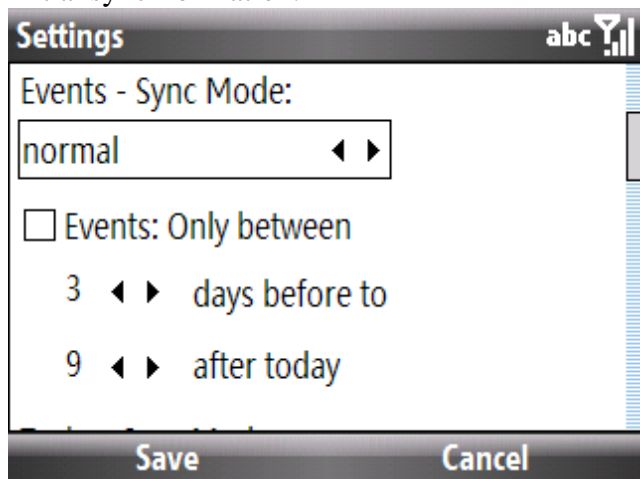

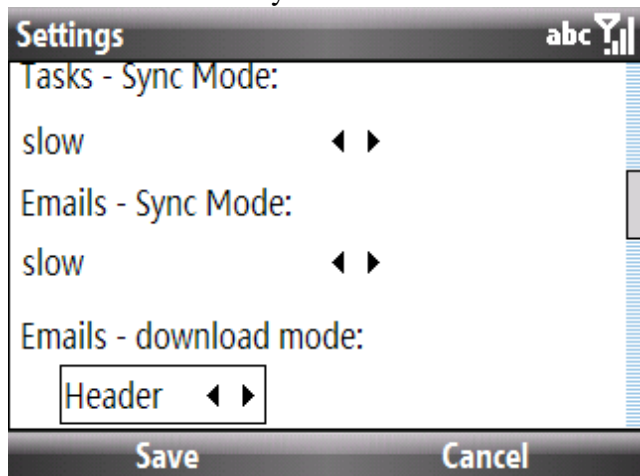
9. Use the default profile and leave "Contacts - Sync Mode:" to slow.



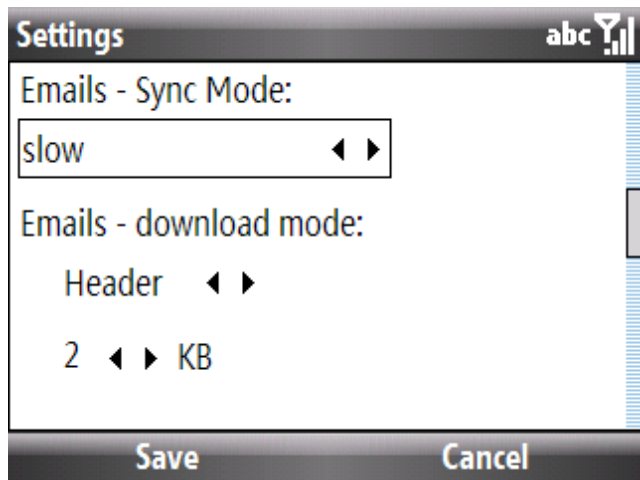
10. Under "Events - Sync Mode:" use normal.
11. If you would like to only sync a certain amount of days in the past and in the future check the "Events: Only between" box and choose the amount of days to synchronize. Making this smaller can speed up the initial synchronization.



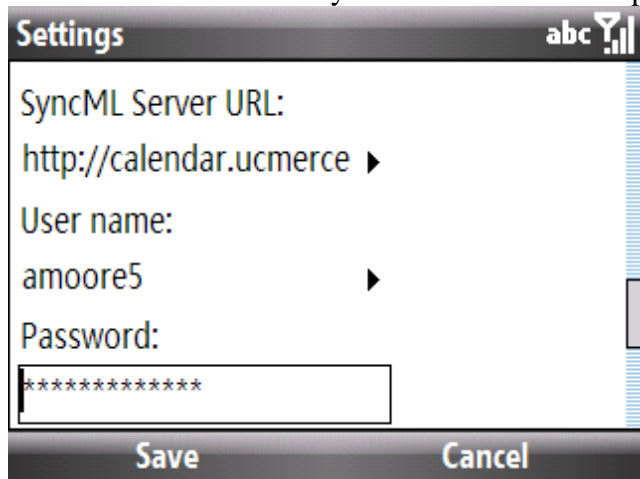
12. Leave the "Tasks - Sync Mode:" to slow.



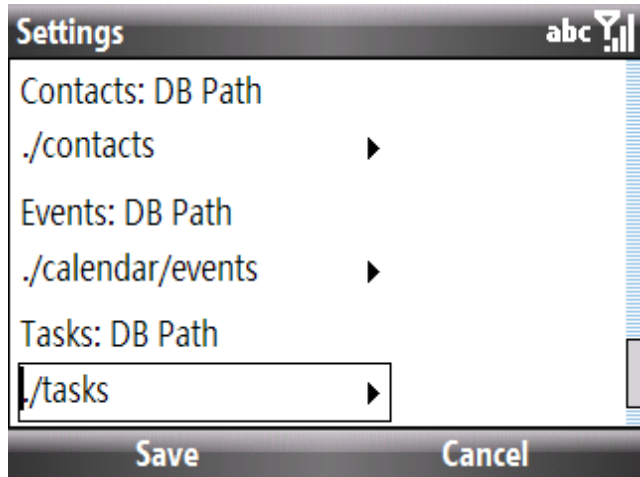
13. Leave the "Emails - Sync Mode:" on slow. Do not change any of the other email settings.



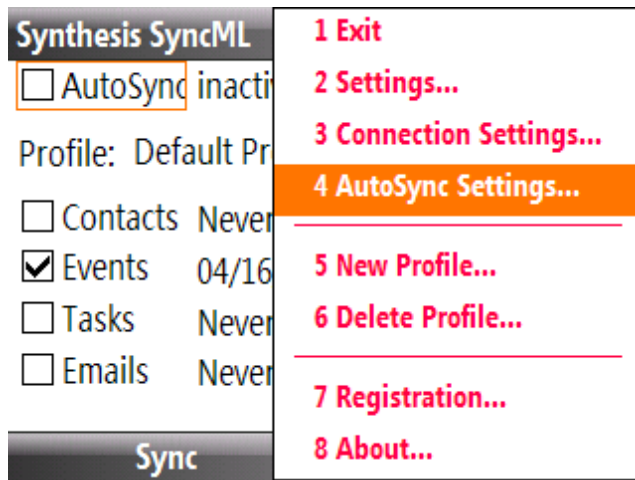
14. Under the "SyncML Server URL:" enter <http://calendar.ucmerced.edu/ocst-bin/ocas.fcgi>
15. Under "User name:" enter your UCM NetID.
16. Under "Password:" enter your UC Merced email password.



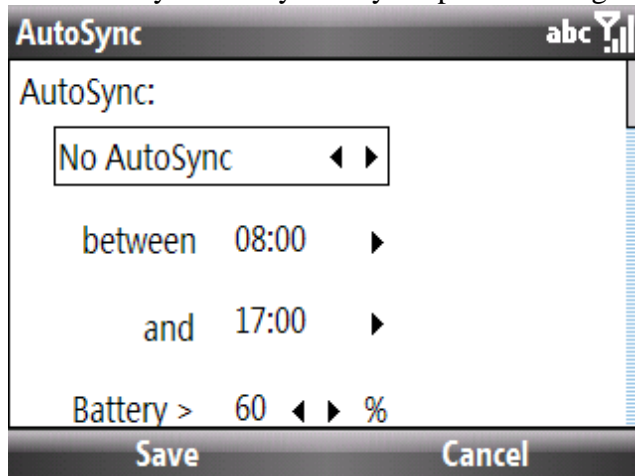
17. Set the "Contacts: DB Path" to ./contacts
18. Set the "Events: DB Path" to ./calendar/events
19. Set the "Tasks: DB Path" to ./tasks
20. Select Save



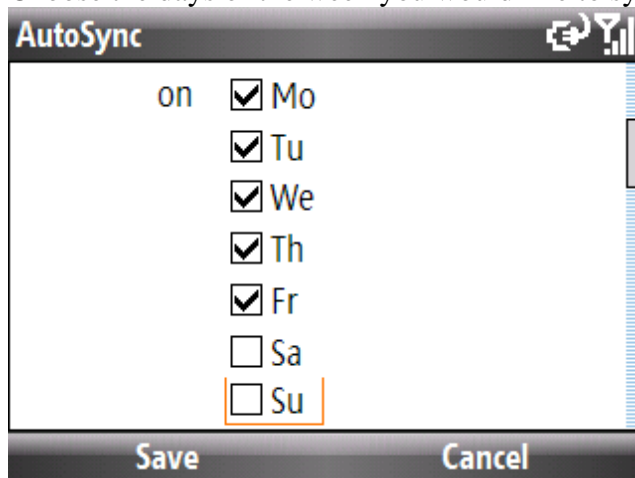
21. Select Menu then AutoSync Settings



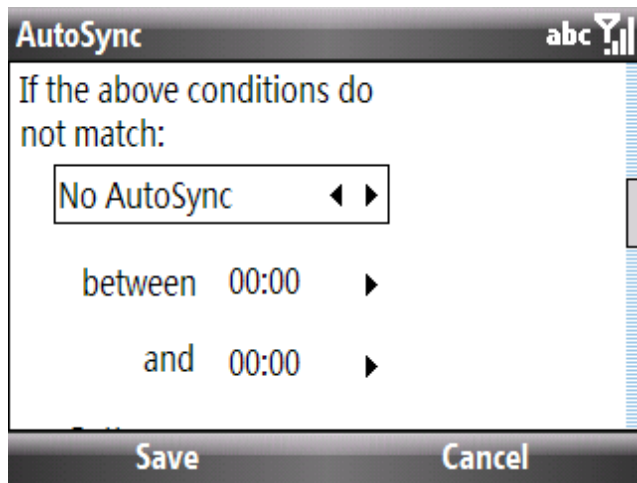
22. If you want to synchronize only during a certain times of the day in the first box select Timed Sync. You will need to at least change this to timed sync for auto-synchronization to work.
23. Choose between which times you would like to synchronize.
24. You can then choose a level of battery that is necessary to perform a synchronization. Synchronization takes battery life away from your phone setting this level will allow you to maximize your battery life.



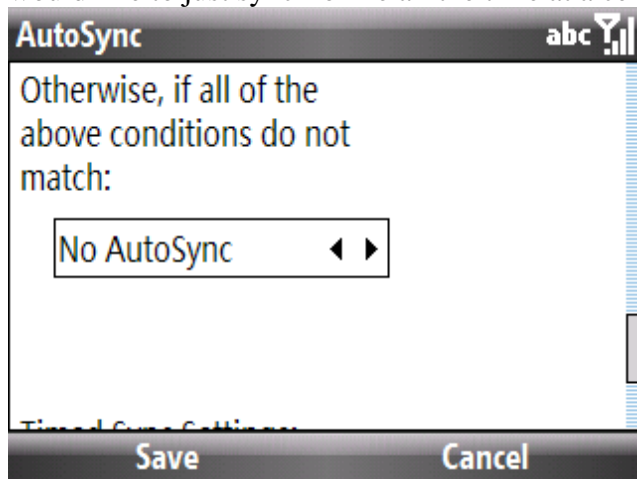
25. Choose the days of the week you would like to synchronize.



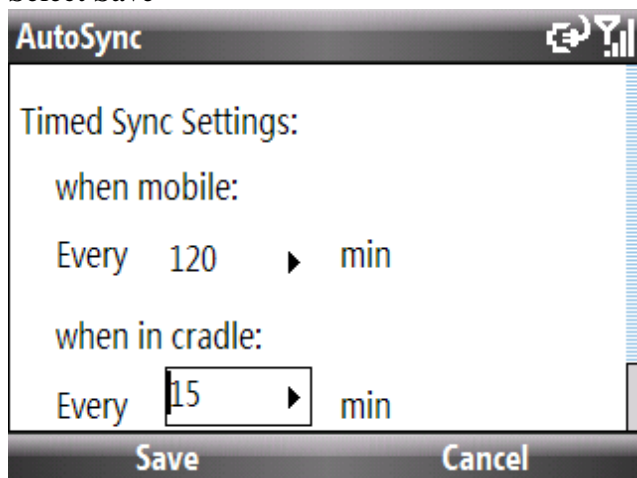
26. If none of the above conditions match then you can choose to synchronize it at a different time, day and battery life.



27. If nothing matches then choose if you would like to synchronize at a timed interval. This is good if you would like to just synchronize all the time at a certain interval.



28. You will then need to choose how often you would like to synchronize. The more often you synchronize the more battery life you lose. 120 minutes when mobile is usually adequate.
29. Select Save



30. Select the items you would like to synchronize. At UC Merced you will not be able to synchronize emails through this tool.
31. Select Sync to synchronize.
