PLANNED HARDWARE UPGRADE

The Summits Residential Building

The Office of Information Technology (OIT) has scheduled a hardware upgrade to The Summit residential building. The upgrade includes an installation of a new local network system.

The shutdown and equipment removal will begin Monday, May 15 at 8 a.m. with network connectivity restored to the building Friday, May 19 at midnight.

Prior to the upgrade it is imperative that users shutdown all network attached equipment. DO NOT unplug the equipment from the wall as this may result in a delay in connectivity.

The building conversion is the next phase in a multi-year, campus-wide upgrade to provide faculty, staff, and students with a faster, more secure, and resilient network – both wired and wireless.
